1. The following are new paragraphs 12-14 of the Complaint:

Plaintiff National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (“NAACP”) is a non-profit, non-partisan corporation with over 300,000 members, many of whom are educators, parents, and students in Florida’s public schools.

Plaintiff Florida State Conference of National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (“NAACP-FL”) is a non-profit, non-partisan organization with about 10,222 active members in the State of Florida, many of whom are educators, parents, and students in Florida’s public schools. NAACP-FL supports the mission of the NAACP by organizing its members in Florida to advocate for educational, political, social and economic equality of rights.

The NAACP and NAACP-FL join this action in their representative capacity on behalf of their members who are adversely, and disproportionately, affected by the State Defendants’ mandate to reopen all brick-and-mortar schools in August.
